

## **Directions to Bridgewater State College Bridgewater Fourth of July Festival for the Arts**

Bridgewater, MA, is located approximately 28 miles south of Boston and 25 miles north of New Bedford.

### **From the South on Route 24**

Follow Route 24N to Exit 15. Take Route 104E approximately 3 miles to a Stop sign. Turn left. Proceed to the rotary at the Town Common. The Academy Building with a fountain will be on your right. Go straight across the top of the rotary onto School Street. A gray church (New Jerusalem) will be on the right corner and the fire station will be on your left. School Street will be blocked about halfway down for the food vendors. Turn right onto Cedar Street and use the parking lot on the left.

### **From the North on Route 24**

Follow Route 24S to Exit 16A. Take Route 106E to Route 28S, approximately 1.5 miles. Turn right onto Route 28S and proceed into Bridgewater. Go straight through the light at the top of the hill (Main, Center and High streets). Stay in the left lane and go straight through the light in the center of Bridgewater (Bridgewater Savings Bank is on your right). At the next light, just after a Mobil station on the left, turn right onto Summer Street. Go past School Street and turn right onto Grove Street. The Festival set-up area will be on your right as you drive up Grove Street (the quadrangle in front of Boyden Hall.)

### **From the West on I-495**

Follow Route I-495S to Exit 7A (Route 24N). Proceed as directed in “From the South on Route 24.”

### **From the East on Route 106**

Follow Route 106W to Route 104W. Follow Route 104 into Bridgewater. Just after the railroad tracks, at the light just before the Mobil Station, turn left onto Summer street. Go past School Street and turn right onto Summer Street. Go past School Street and turn right onto Grove Street. The Festival set-up area will be on your right as you drive up Grove Street (the quadrangle in front of Boyden Hall.)

### **From the North on Route 18**

Follow Route 18S to the center of Bridgewater. D’Angelo’s will be on your left. Go straight through the light. At the top of the rotary/Town Common, turn left onto School Street. A gray church (New Jerusalem) will be on the right corner and the fire station will be on your left. School Street will be blocked about halfway down for the food vendors. Turn right onto Cedar Street and use the parking lot on the left.

Main Street is Rte. 104 – follow it into the Center of town (comes from West Bridgewater Rte. 106).

Broad St. is Rte 18 from the North – from S. Weymouth, Abington, and East Bridgewater.

Rte 104 is Pleasant Street, and comes from Rte 24, and also town of Raynham.

Bedford St. is Rte 18 from the Middleboro rotary.
